ATV Route Ordinance

Ordinance No. 2021-1

Ordinance Dated: January 5, 2021

(1) INTENT

The Town of Kinnickinnic, St Croix County adopts the following all-terrain vehicle route for the operation of all-terrain vehicles upon the roadways listed in Section 3.

Following due consideration of the recreational value and weighted against possible dangers, public health, liability aspects, terrain involved, traffic density and history of automobile traffic, this route(s) has been created.

(2) STATUTORY AUTHORITY

This route is created pursuant to Town authority as authorized by Wis. Stats. 23.33(8)(b).

The applicable provisions of Wis. Stats. 23.33 regulating ATV operation pursuant to routes are adopted.

(3) ROUTES

All Town roads within the Town of Kinnickinnic are designated ATV routes.

(4) CONDITIONS

As a condition for the use of this route, the following conditions shall apply to all operators (and passengers);

- A. All ATV operators shall observe posted roadway speed limits.
- B. All ATV operators shall ride single file.
- C. All ATV operators shall slow the vehicle to 10-mph or less when operating within 100 feet of a person not on a motorized vehicle.
- D. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12 and NR 64.12(7)c.

(5) ROUTE SIGNS

All required designated route signs shall be paid for and installed by an ATV club or association, under the direction of the Town of Kinnickinnic.

(6) ENFORCEMENT

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce laws of the State of Wisconsin.

(7) PENALTIES

Wisconsin State All-Terrain Vehicle penalties as found in Wis. Stats. 23.33(13)(a), are adopted by reference.

(8) SEVERABILITY


The provision of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town would have passed other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons circumstances shall not be deemed affected.

(9) EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance becomes effective upon passage, publication and signage installation.
